




INPATIENT MORTALITY RATE




AGE DISTRIBUTION CHANGES: 2006 vs. 2016

AVERAGE PATIENT AGE WITH MEDICAL/SURGICAL SPLIT



PROPORTION OF ADMISSIONS WITH A CHRONIC DISEASE CODE






PATIENTS VIA EMERGENCY UNIT (2006 – 2016)





SURGICAL TRAUMA PATIENTS (2006 – 2016)








DAYCASE/INPATIENT SPLIT (2006 – 2016)






ISM ACUITY LEVEL DISTRIBUTION - GENERAL UNITS






ISM ACUITY LEVEL DISTRIBUTION - CRITICAL CARE UNITS




